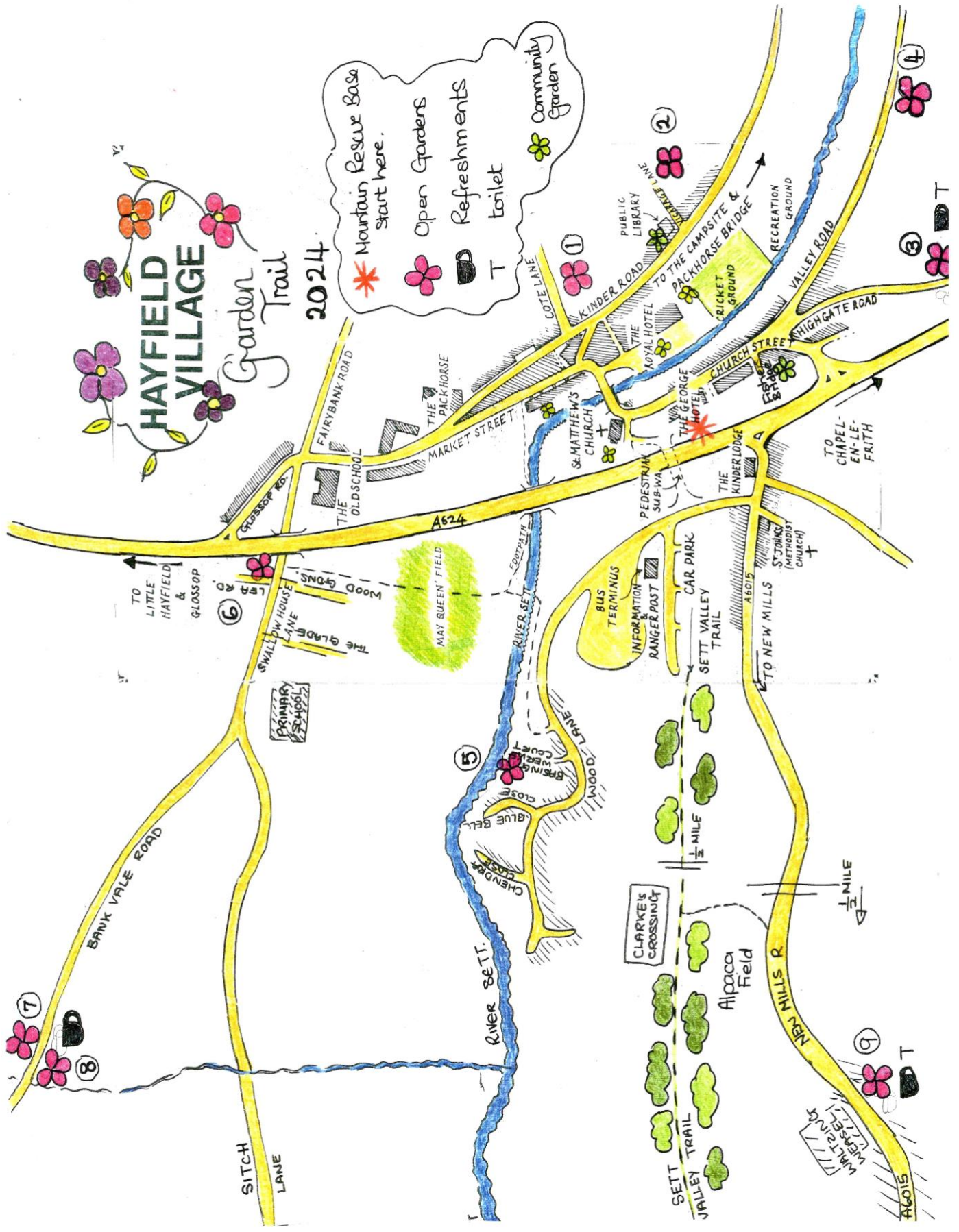


# HAYFIELD VILLAGE Garden Trail 2024

# Hayfield Open Garden Trail July 20 2024

- 1. Kinder Road (access from Cote Lane)** A small garden on several levels designed as a functional space for working as well as relaxation and interest throughout the year.
- 2. 8 Vicarage Lane:** A delightful small garden tucked away near the library with lots of pots and lovely hostas!
- 3. Nut Farm Cottage, High gate Rd:** A large cottage garden in an elevated position with views of Kinder and the surrounding hills.

- 4. Valley Road:** An untamed natural garden in the process of being a little more organised. Inspiring eyes welcome!
- 5. 1 Basingwerke Court (off Wood Lane):** A level courtyard garden including a wooden bear with an interesting story, carved by a local craftsman.
- 6. 3 Lea Road:** A pretty front garden with a delightful allotment style garden hidden away at the back. Raised beds filled with vegetables and a wide variety of fruit and trained apple trees.
- 7. Primrose Cottage, Bank Vale:** A secret country cottage garden hidden away with a stream running through it. Terraced with some steps.  
*(Tea & Cake jointly with Bank House)*
- 8. Bank House, Bank Vale:** A lovely detached streamside garden. Features a recently developed wildflower area and pond.
- 9. 7 New Mills Road (Opposite Waltzing Weasel):** A large country cottage style garden on several levels with scented roses, nature pond and lovely views.

KMRT are based in Hayfield and provide a 24/7/365 search and rescue service for Kinder Scout and the surrounding area. We have between 40 and 50 callouts a year to people who are injured, have medical conditions or are lost. We regularly deal with fatalities. Whilst many of our callouts are on Kinder Scout, we also operate in our local area to help the police with searches for missing vulnerable people and the ambulance service with patients in difficult locations.

It costs around £40,000 a year to run the team, all funded through voluntary donation. Our last Garden Trail raised £2,500 towards our new Land rover, which has just arrived.
